DPVA Volunteer Spotlight

My parents said I sang before I spoke; they called me J Bird as a result," says this quarter's Dayton Philharmonic Volunteer Association Spotlight Volunteer, J Stanton.

J has been the head of DPVA's immensely successful program, "It's Instrumental" since 2008. "When I was offered this role I jumped on it," J says, "Instrumental music has been such an important part of my life, I wanted to do all that I could to make sure every child had the opportunity I did. What we know about music education in young people is that it has a direct correlation to success in other academic areas. I speak four languages, three are spoken and the other language I proudly "speak" is music."

Since its inception, the DPVA's "It's Instrumental" program has collected over 300 used instruments, that were serviced to make sure they are in working condition, and then donated to students in the Dayton Public School system, to help previously cut music programs make a comeback.

J attributes the program's success to the partnership with Shaun Yu at Discover Classical WDPR/WDPG, and John Marshall at Grismer Tire. "We are so very fortunate to have a world class arts community here in Dayton and so many dedicated individuals who play a part in making it as successful as it is."

J goes on to say "The drive wouldn't be a hit without the kind and giving people of the Miami Valley who give up instruments that are no longer being played so that they can again make music."

When J isn't volunteering his time at DPVA, he works as the Director of Sales at the Wilderness Agency, as well playing piano at the Paragon Supper Club and being a courier for donor organs. We're glad to have him on the team!
