Founded in 1937 by Paul Katz, the Dayton Philharmonic Youth Orchestra brings together the greater Dayton area's most gifted young orchestral musicians, providing the opportunity to study and perform a broad range of orchestral repertoire.

On Sunday, December 8, the DPYO performed their first concert of the 2019-2020 Season at the Schuster Center. They began their program with a selection of Georges Bizet's *L'Arlesienne Suites* followed by two pieces from Duke Ellington's work *Three Black Kings*. They continued with *Lyric for Strings* by George Walker and closed the program with Rimsky-Korsakov's *Capriccio Espagnol*.



The audience was thrilled by the high level of musicianship exhibited by these young musicians under the incredibly supportive baton of Dr. Patrick Reynolds.
